Dear Mr. Morayo,

On behalf of the International Society for Weigh-in-Motion (ISWIM), I thank you for accepting us as an organisation in liaison with the OIML TC9/SC2/p11 for the revision of the R134: 2006 Automatic instruments for weighing road vehicles in motion and measuring axle loads.

ISWIM is a non-profit organization, founded in 2008, representing WIM researchers, end-users, and vendors/consultants. ISWIM comprises around 1000 individual members from 75 countries and 24 vendor/consultant college members.

We plan to collect comments from our member base, synthesise and submit them to the TC9/SC2/ p11.
