



ICWIM7, Foz do Iguaçu, Nov. 7-10, 2016

Call for posters (without paper)

This call for posters complements the previous call for abstracts and papers (closed since November 15, 2015) and encourages more participation at ICWIM7, e.g. industrials, young researchers, on-going research projects and practitioners for case studies. The objectives of this posters call are to demonstrate the impact of research on industrial deployment and the implementation and use of WIM for various purposes. Industrial companies and practitioners are invited to actively contribute to the ICWIM7 by showcasing achievements of industrial research. These posters will be displayed in an information arena and will be used for brainstorming and discussion between their authors and the delegates.

These posters should contain industrial innovations, case studies, implementation of research work, or industrial projects where preliminary results are available, including clear objectives and a detailed methodology for the research. Original, recent and substantive achievements are expected. However, commercial advertising or the presentation of market products only cannot be accepted as posters. Displays containing this type of information will be welcome in company exhibition booths.

The posters should address one or more of ICWIM7 themes shown below. Poster submissions will be reviewed by July 15, 2016, and the author(s) will be informed of acceptance (with or without modification) or rejection. Accepted/revised posters will be published in the e-proceedings that will be distributed to the registered delegates at the conference.

Authors are invited to submit posters only, without published paper, before May 31, 2016. A ready-for-presentation poster without abstract should be submitted, both in PPT, PPTX or ODP and PDF format, on: www.is-wim.org/icwim7/ (use a file transfer system for files above 10 Mb), in English language using the provided template. After acceptance (by late June), authors will have to print their posters and deliver them on site.

Accepted posters will be displayed in the exhibition area for at least one full day of the conference. Authors must bring their printed poster (A0 format, H=1.2 m, W=0.8 m) to ICWIM7 for posting on the designated location and day. Posters must be removed by the authors on the designated day. The conference organizers will provide mounting boards and materials for poster installation.

At least one author per poster must be registered to ICWIM7 before June 30, 2016 and attend the conference to present the poster. An author cannot endorse more than 2 posters.

By submitting a poster to ICWIM7, the authors automatically transfer its Copyright to ISWIM for publication in the e-proceedings of the conference and on the ISWIM web site.

ICWIM7 themes

- WIM sensors, technologies and testing,
- WIM systems, users' perspectives, experience with WIM, WIM for railways and onboard weighing,
- WIM standards and specifications,
- WIM data quality, management and use,
- Application of WIM to enforcement and toll-by-weight,
- Applications of WIM to infrastructure design, maintenance and assessment,
- WIM in ITS, traffic management and monitoring, and for road safety purposes.
