If you are interested in the conference, please sign up on the International Society for Weigh-in-Motion (ISWIM) website. It is free of charge and without any obligations, and makes it possible for you to submit an abstract and later to register for the conference. You will then receive announcements and further information. The most up-to-date information on the web pages of the conference may be accessed at any time.

To submit an abstract, all your co-authors should first sign up on ISWIM and complete the form. Then using your login and password, you may submit one or more abstracts on line. You will receive information on abstract acceptance by the June 2018.

**Abstract submission deadline: 31<sup>st</sup> March 2018.**

If your abstract is accepted, the full paper will be due by October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018. To get a paper published in the proceedings and presented at the conference, at least one author must register for the conference by December 31, 2018. One author cannot register for more than two papers, but may be author or co-author of an unlimited number of papers.

As soon as the conference registration opens, information will be sent to all those who have signed up. The ICWIM8 will be organized as a series of scientific and technical sessions, poster sessions, panel discussions and end-users/vendors workshops. An exhibition will also be organized.

The early bird registration will end by February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

## About the Conference

The 8<sup>th</sup> International Conference on Weigh-In-Motion – ICWIM8 will be held in Prague, Czech Republic. After North and South America, the conference comes back to Europe. The hosts are Centrum Dopravního Výzkumu (CDV) ....

ICWIM has been held every three to four years since 1995. Locations have included Zürich, Lisbon, Orlando, Taipei, Paris, Dallas and Foz do Iguacu.

ICWIM8 will be held as a series of dedicated sessions, panel discussions and forums where the end-users will get information about the best practices and the application of WIM data. WIM vendors and consultants will present their solutions and end-users can share their experiences and best practices.

The conference is designed to address the broad range of technical topics related to heavy vehicles weight and size, load and mass measurement systems, providing access to current research, best practices and related policy issues. It is a multi-disciplinary, inter-agency supported event.

## Objectives

- Provide an international forum for WIM technologies, standards, research, policy, operations and applications.
- Facilitate the meeting of manufacturers, vendors and users in workshops and an exhibition of WIM systems, sensors and related technologies.
- Review new developments since the last International conference – ICWIM7, held in Brazil.

## Who Should Attend

- Researchers in WIM technologies, WIM data analysis, vehicle-road or railway interaction and freight logistics.
- Manufacturers, vendors and users of WIM (including onboard weighing) systems, data, or related equipments and services.
- Policy makers and agencies responsible for heavy vehicle operation and control, weight and size enforcement, road and railway infrastructures design, construction and maintenance.

- Road, bridge and infrastructure managers.
- Agencies that use weight information to support freight mobility, safety and road pricing.
- Students in freight transport and road infrastructures.

## Parallel Exhibition

A showcase for manufacturers, users and related industries will be held in conjunction with the conference.

## Themes

The conference will cover themes as follow:

- WIM sensors, technologies and testing,
- WIM systems, users' perspectives, experience with WIM, WIM for railways and onboard weighing,
- WIM standards and specifications,
- WIM data quality, management and use,
- Application of WIM to enforcement and toll-by-weight,
- Applications of WIM to infrastructure,,
- WIM in ITS, traffic management and monitoring, and for road safety purposes.

The official language of the conference will be English. Final papers and posters must be provided in English, if possible with abstracts in French and German.
